Definition

- Bred two or more times
- Good quality semen or bred by a fertile bull
- Failed to conceive
 - ➤ Normal estrous cycles 21 days
 - > Free from palpable abnormalities
 - **➤** Normal vaginal discharges
 - Positive energy balance
 - > Calved atleast once
 - > Less than 10 years old







Prevalence

Crossbred cows (17.57%)

• Buffaloes (12.74%)

Indigenous cows (8.64%)

• 30.4% of cattle and buffaloes were culled mainly due to infertility





Zemjanis and Roberts classification

- Congenital or genetic anatomical defects of the reproductive tract in cows
- Congenital or genetic acquired defects of sperm, ovum and zygote
- Infectious or traumatic inflammatory causes (processes)
- Endocrine dysfunction
- Managerial causes and nutritional deficiency
