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Parameters

- Temperature
- Heart rate
- Colour of mucous membrane

How to exam a Downer

- Mental Status
- Temperature
- Heart Rate
- Mucous membrane
- Rummation
- Dung
- Urine
- Reflexes to stimuli (Pin prick.. Pain stimuli)

How to exam a Downer

- Feeding Habit
- Rumination
- Rumen consistency
- Dung/ urine voided or not
- Trying to get up or not
- Reflexes

Reflexes

- **Pin Prick reflex**
- **Menace reflex**
- **Palpebral reflex**
- **Corneal reflex**

Udder Examination

- All quarter of Udder
- Teat examination
- Milk – colour and consistency

- **Palpation of hind quarters, Joints**
- **Symmetry of hind limbs**
- **Achilles tendon**
- **Rectal examination**

Posture

- Sternal
- Lateral – (Bloat ?)
- Knuckling of fetlock





Serum biochemical profile

- Calcium
- Phosphorus
- Potassium
- Magnesium
- Creatinine kinase
- AST – Prognostic Indicator
