# Technological perspectives with respect to socio-economic context of farmers

- Probability of risk
  - Cost associated

Proper rainfed dryland technologies are those, which can reduce the risk of failure, produce optimum economic return and change the conservative attitude of the farmers

# **EXTENSION STRATEGY FOR DRYLAND AGRICULTURE**

Farmers in the dryland areas do not have access to modern sources of information

Technology transfer in rainfed areas needs special attention because of problems unique to such areas

- A limited range of technologies is available from extension agencies for rainfed areas
- These agencies need to initiate group action and mobilize communities to adopt rainfed farming technologies and manage natural resources

Assured farmer participation in technology development and dissemination is the key to success in dryland extension efforts because farmers have EXPERIENCE and LOCAL INSIGHT

Extension approach works well in this direction where farmers

act as Principal agents of change

# **Extension approaches**

1.Technology centered extension

Focus is on <u>disseminating</u> technology

2.Farmer centered extension

Promotes welfare of farmers by using technology

as a <u>vehicle</u> for development

# Why FCE?

The farmer centered extension approach is more effective as it:

- Facilitates access to remote areas not easily served by extension agents
- \* Establishes quick and better rapport with the farming community
- Operate on a low budget
- \* Provides timely as well as efficient and effective extension services
